- **YEAR-END FINANCIAL OVERVIEW-** Treasurer Report given by Kathy Rolfe. Total income \$6477.15, expenses \$1501.71 for a net gain of \$4975.44.
- **Kathy Rolfe**, was elected to the Board to for another term expiring 12/31/23. Kathy remains as the Secretary-Treasurer.
- **Lynne Wenski** is continuing as President. The position of Vice-President remains vacant.
- **Discussion of Plans for 2021:**

 - Summer Youth lessons ahead of Friendly Friday Game as last summer, will apply for grant by early April

 - Purchasing Bridge+More dealers for 6 tables, charge rental to Carriage Club to use for their games (\$15 per game)
 - Starting up the Friendly Friday games, possible as early as March with Covid-19 precautions in place.
 - Possibly working with Unit 131 Task Force to use Mo-Kan as the organizing body for a new bridge center in the metro area..
