Summary of email agreements between 11/10/18 and 12/21/18

11/23/18:

1. Proceeding with insurance purchase and Business cards approved.
2. Membership structure approved. Membership does not come with any voting rights, but does provide \$2 discount per game or lesson. To serve as an officer requires membership, but membership is not required to be a Board Member. Membership will be \$125 through 12-31-20 with \$25 per year renewal after that. Memberships purchased after we are in our new space in 2020 or later will be sold for \$125 for just 1 year, still with a \$25 annual renewal. Membership year ends with calendar year.
3. Robert plans to work with Isabell Shaw (as recommended by Jim Dorman) in finding a space suitable to lease.

11/30/18:

After several email discussions, the structure of the Holy Spirit game, a flyer to advertise that game authorized, and game expenses approved, including director pay.

1. Directors are to be paid \$50 for the first game and an additional \$25 if a second game is offered at the same session. In addition, the director will receive \$5 per table beyond a total of 9 tables per session. The director shall not play (unless necessary as a last minute partner) if the table count is 9 or higher.
2. For the Friendly Friday Duplicate, we are guaranteeing a partner if someone cannot find one on their own. We will either help them find one or if they come without a partner we will match them with someone else in the same situation or the director will play with them. This may require that they play in the open game, rather than the 49er game.
3. We will provide duplicated boards and hand records. We anticipate joining the Common Game for the Friendly Friday game.
4. The Friendly Friday game will have lunch provided, (liability insurance is being purchased).
5. Cost to play in Friendly Friday: \$8 without Mo-Kan membership, \$6 with membership. The first game you play in, you get the \$2 discount as long as you are at least an ACBL member. \$7.99 ACBL 1 month trial memberships can be purchased at the door and then you can play for just \$1 your first time. Youth always play at half-price.
